Travel program update – Babe Ruth/Cal Ripken, USA Softball/Fast pitch

- Moving forward with Practices beginning this week 5/18
- Games looking to begin early June as scheduled

In-house program plan update (Participant/Spectator recommendations)

- Moving forward. Most organizations have spread out start dates to minimize program overlapping/traffic
- Facility guidelines should be in place for all sports complexes
 - Unique to each facility due to location and facility design

Concession stand protocols – Want to see what everyone is planning to do here.

- Moving forward – some serving only prepackaged foods to begin with
- Minimize touch points
 - Condiments
 - Napkins
 - Must be able to social distance the line.
- Staff guidelines should be in place and enforced

Covid-19 response – protocol if a participant is diagnosed in a program – update to what was previously suggested by the group.

- Williston will not be shutting down programs if a participant gets sick.
 - We will be compliant with the Department of Health but will not be running any investigations of our own.
